Community Maintenance Activities

February was a long month in regards to snow events. We are very pleased at how well the contractor performed after a slow start in January. We are hopeful that we are done with snow events for the year and Harmony will start removing the snow stakes and repairing any damage from this winters snow removal. The parking lot which was occupied with the snow removal equipment will be cleaned up by early April.

See enclosed with this newsletter a copy of the proposed schedule for the 2021 spring landscape season.

We continue to work with vendors on planning the removal of dead Ash trees. As soon as we have a schedule we will send this out to the community.

The new pond fountain will be re-installed on or about April 1st. We are hoping that getting the fountain in early this year we can avoid some of the algae issues we experienced last year. This will be in combination with an aggressive water treatment plan.

The tennis courts along with the basketball hoop are now open for use. Please take advantage of the new surface. We did experience some "dead" areas on the court after the new installation and the company who installed the court will be checking and repairing these areas ASAP.

Two more roofs have been recently been replace in the community, one on Birch and one on Sycamore. We continue to monitor any roofing issues and where needed replace roofs.

We are actively working on preparations to try and open the pool for the summer months. We plan on checking, repairing, cleaning and getting the pool up and running in the next month. We are still reviewing the state and local guidelines as well as the association's insurance policies to see if the association can safely open the pool for the summer. We are going to move forward as if we will open but have not yet made any decision to do so.

- Looking into investment accounts for additional yield with flexibility and no risk to principle.
- 3. Maintenance Report
 - Snow: Biggest storm in many years. All four properties that Taylor Management manages had issues. While it took time to dig out from the regular snow storms, we had regular communication and feedback exchange with Harmony (our vendor). Harmony is learning our property, and we have improved regular communications to the community.
 - Feedback from the community: timely and frequent communications have been a big plus.
 - With additional snow, ice damming and in gutters is increased.
 - Some roof leaks also as a result and have been addressing them timely.
 - Spring Tree Removal: We can begin to address Ash tree removal again as spring comes. One more contractor will be coming to provide competing estimates.
 - Flag: Flag was replaced recently.
 - Siding and painting: Siding and painting repairs continue.
 - Pool: We are looking into how, if, when the pool can open. Only one of Gary's properties was able to open the pool and it was expensive. Biggest factor is the insurance.

 - Flag: Can we consider taking it down? Can use the donated flag for the community from the Strongs.
 - Pool: Looking forward to open dialogue and conversation. Major issue is the insurance coverage, and
 we expect to find more information as we get closer to summer. Hopefully, we can make something
 work, especially since we have vaccinations now.

Harding Green – 2021 Landscape Schedule

While the specific dates are driven by the weather and growing conditions, below please find a landscape plan for 2021.

Phase of Landscaping	Start Date
Spring Clean Up	By March 29 ^{th -} We would like to start March 15 th , but with piles of snow still present and soft ground to follow the melting snow, we will likely need to wait. We would like to start as soon as possible
Lawn fertilization &	By April 15
pre-emergent weed treatment	
Mulch	By May 15
Lawn post-emergent weed treatment	By May 15
The first post-emergent weed	
treatment is primarily to treat weeds	
that set up in the fall, like Dandelion	
2 nd - Lawn fertilization &	By June 1st
pre-emergent weed treatment	
Summer weed treatment	By July 1 st

Summer pruning	By July 1 st
Fall Pruning	By September 15to allow the pruning cuts time to "harden off" for winter
Fall Fertilizer	By October 15 th
	To help strengthen lawn roots for winter

Additional Measures to Consider

- Liquid Aeration and the addition of humates in Spring. This helps to:
 - Stimulate biological activity in the soil
 - o Improve needed air exchange in our otherwise compacted clay soils.
 - Organic components help to reduce leaching and to help roots access nutrients in the soil.
 - Improves the soils water holding capacity for greater drought tolerance
 - Root stimulators to enhance root growth

These factors contribute to more healthy roots which leads to a more healthy lawn.

We used this product last year (at our expense). Improvements in the soil health contributed to good results in the Fall. We recommend continuing with this program.

Corrective PH treatment (subject to results of soil test). We expect that the
soil test will indicate the need for this as it takes time to correct a
significant PH in-balance. Also, the dense population of trees at Harding
Green leads to a more acidic soil given the ongoing impact of tree root
activity to increase soil acidity.

- Late August / Early September Aeration and overseeding with fescue seed. Fescue lawns are more hearty, drought, disease and insect resistant. This type of seed requires more time to germinate, so we need to start late summer/ very early fall and hope to get lucky with rain given no irrigation. Probability of rain and more favorable (cool) growing conditions are better in the Fall than in the Spring.
- Lawn overhaul behind Spruce. The lawn in this area is poor and removal of the trees and stump grinding will make it worse. Consider scheduling lawn overhaul in this area for late August/very early September to be able to use fescue seed and for a greater chance for more favorable growing conditions as rain and mild temperatures are needed for success.
